Managing CEUs and CFM Maintenance Points

To receive Continuing Education Units (CEUs):

- Pay the US\$15 processing fee via registration.

- Complete the session evaluation; then take the five-question CEU assessment.
- After passing the assessment, you will receive your certificate of completion.
